

BANA Word List Viewer - Student Quick Guide

Purpose

BANA Word List Viewer opens Merriam-Webster pages for your spelling or vocabulary words.

What You Need

- BANAWordListViewer.exe
- A CSV file with words in the first column
- Internet connection

Start (No Command Line Needed)

1. Double-click BANAWordListViewer.exe.
2. The UI opens automatically.

Note: You do not need to type --ui. Clicking the EXE is enough.

Use the App

1. Click Browse.
2. Choose your CSV file.
3. Click Load.
4. Click any word in the list.
5. Your browser opens the Merriam-Webster page for that word.

Optional:

- Select a word and click Open Selected.

CSV Format

- Put each word in the first column.
- A first-row header like Word is fine.
- Duplicate words are removed automatically.

Example:

Word

apple

benevolent

catastrophe

Troubleshooting

- Nothing opens: confirm internet access, then try another word.
- Tabs are blocked: allow pop-ups/new tabs in your browser.
- CSV does not load: confirm the file extension is .csv.
- Windows warning appears: click More info, then Run anyway (only if your teacher/school provided the file).

Tips

- Keep BANAWordListViewer.exe and your CSV in the same folder.
- Use one word per row for best results.
